UCSF continues to follow COVID-19 health protocols on campus. <u>All visitors are required to complete</u> the UCSF Campus Guest Daily Health Screening survey. The link is listed below.

Visiting Requirements for all Non-UCSF Essential Associates Hosted Individually by UCSF Faculty and Staff

- 1. If sick or showing new symptoms consistent with COVID-19, seek immediate action: do not enter campus facilities, call your health care provider, and immediately follow the <u>CDC home</u> isolation quarantine.
- 2. Comply with <u>UCSF's face covering</u> and other COVID protocols noted on building signs.
- 3. Complete the <u>UCSF Vendor & Campus Guest Daily Health Screening</u> and present an entry pass when requested to do so.
 - a. Vaccinated Non-UCSF guests (individuals that are not UCSF faculty, staff and learners) must complete the Digital Screener and follow UCSF screener requirements.
 - b. Unvaccinated Non-UCSF guests must receive a negative COVID-19 antigen test performed each morning of the event, and complete the <u>Digital Screener</u> and follow UCSF screener requirements.

Those who do not pass the health screen are prohibited from visiting UCSF and are advised to call their health care provider. Well in advance of entry to the UCSF campus, click on the screening link above to review screener requirements. The Vendor and Guest Screeners have a specific pathway for Non-UCSF Essential Associates to enter campus, and they must attest to compliance with the symptom and extra testing requirements.
